The Energy Vision Advisory Committee (EVAC) is charged with reviewing and providing feedback on the biennial work plan and measurement and performance reports; providing feedback on special initiatives as requested by the Board; and communicating to members' respective constituencies about EVAC and Board decisions and activities. Members should be a resident, business or organization located within the City of Minneapolis. Preference will be given to individuals or entities with a history of working in or with the city.
